CASE #2

ASPEN: ~8-month-old stray male domestic short hair brought to Dr. Vanessa Adams at PGA Animal Clinic by a rescue organization (Palm Beach Purrs). He was found roaming the streets in Clewiston, FL. Diagnosed with endo- and ectoparasites, and suffering from what's suspected to be chemical burns covering much of his body. He was given Convenia, dewormer, and pain meds and began Phovia on 2/11/22.

February 10, 2022: After preparing the lesion.
Phovia application #1 next day

February 16, 2022: No Phovia

February 20, 2022: 2 days after Phovia application #2
